# About the Hotel

Originally a public house named The Black Prince was inspired by the local 14th-century history surrounding Prince Edward, King Edward III's eldest son.

Built in the 1930s this venue always held events and entertainment at its heart, especially during the 60's/70's when it was a popular music venue hosting acts including The Rolling Stones, Eric Clapton, and Genesis.

Today the Hotel keeps its beautiful Tudorbethan-style architecture on the main building, with all 107 bedrooms built in the 80s as an attached extension. The event space now acts as our Academy, a multi-functional event space comprised of our two large Suites, four smaller rooms, and a breakout area that leads out onto our landscaped gardens and patio, which are perfect for photo backdrops.

The Black Prince and The Edwards Suites are both licensed for civil weddings and civil partnerships to take place. A marriage can take place in the Hotel any day of the week between 8 am and 6 pm, but we cannot host religious ceremonies on site. The entire Academy is hired privately for your Wedding Day with a separate function bar for you and your guests to use. You will still have full access to our open-planned bar and lounge. We recommend arranging a show round with your coordinator to discuss your requirements while showing you everything the venue has to offer.

### Terms and Conditions

#### 1. Numbers booked

Provisional numbers will be asked for/pre-stated at the time of booking and the hotel reserves the right to stipulate a minimum number to be charged for the event. Final numbers must be confirmed 4 weeks prior to the event and, subject to a minimum number; this will be the number to derive charges.

#### 2. Payment

- a) A non-refundable deposit of £600.00 is due at time of booking to hold the date.
- b) The initial non-refundable payment of £600 can only be accepted if paid by a debit/credit card in order to secure your booking.
- c) Credit card details are required to reserve the booking and will be taken at the time of reservation in case of any additional extras on the account due to be settled on departure.

The Payment schedule must be met as follows:

- 12months Prior—£600 to be paid towards your final balance
- 6 months Prior—£1000 to be paid towards your final remaining balance
  - 3 months prior 50% of your final remaining balance to be paid
    - 1 month prior— Full and final payment required

#### 3. Cancellation by the Customer

- a) Should you cancel your booking a charge must be made equivalent to any loss suffered by the hotel. Costs incurred for any equipment hired by the hotel on your behalf will be added to any cancellation fee. The initial deposit payment is non-refundable.
- b) All payments made according to or outside of the payment plan are non-returnable but may be transferred (less the initial deposit) c) The following percentages of the total amount pre-booked will be charged:
  - 6 12 months = 50% of the total charge.
  - Within 6 months = 100% of total charge.

#### 4. Cancellation by the Hotel

The hotel may cancel the booking at any time and without any obligation to you in any of the following circumstances:

a) If the hotel or any part of it is closed due to fire, alteration or re-decoration, by order of any public authority, or through any reason beyond the hotel's control.

- b) If you are more than 30 days in arrears with payment to the hotel or the Company for previously supplied services.
  - c) If the event may, in the hotel Manager's reasonable opinion, prejudice the reputation of the hotel.

#### 5. Liabilities

- a) Please safeguard your property. The hotel will not accept any liability loss or damage to property of death or illness of or injury to persons unless caused by the hotel's negligence.
- b) Unless the hotel is liable as referred to in (a), you will indemnify the hotel from and against any and all liability for loss or damage to property arising there from as a result of the event.
- c) Any equipment hired for your function from an external supplier remains your responsibility for your event. If any items are lost or damaged there may be charges applied to replace the items. Items are left on the property before/after the event at your own risk.
- d) The Hirer shall be held responsible for the total cost of making good damage done to the premises, furniture, fittings or apparatus, or for the replacement of any articles that may be stolen, broken or damaged by the hirer or their guests during the period of occupation.

  Recorded CCTV is in operation at the Venue.
- e) If you are hiring in outside entertainment please be aware that they need to send in copies of Public Liability Insurance certificates & PAT Test Certificate for all equipment.
  - f) Please ensure only bio degradable confetti is used on the hotel grounds.

### Frequently Asked Questions

Can guests park at the hotel? - Yes, parking is free for anyone that attends your wedding but everyone does need to register their vehicles at the reception. If guests are staying overnight or leaving their cars, there is an overnight fee. Please check with your coordinator to see if parking is included in certain bedroom rates.

Can we have external catering? - We do not allow for external catering at the hotel due to health and safety regulations. However, if you are looking for a particular catering style or cuisine please speak to the team to see if we can accommodate you! We do allow for cakes, sweet carts, chocolate fountains, etc to be supplied externally for your day.

Can we bring our own alcohol? - No, but we do have a fully stocked bar with a varied range of products for you!

**Can we use our own suppliers?** - Absolutely! We do require that all suppliers provide public liability insurance before the event. If they use any electrical equipment they must be able to supply PAT testing certificates.

**Do I have to get married at the venue?** - Only if you want to! We are a fully licensed venue but are happy for you to have your ceremony off-site and come back to us for the reception, whether you have a full meal or just a party!
